Hiker Hints

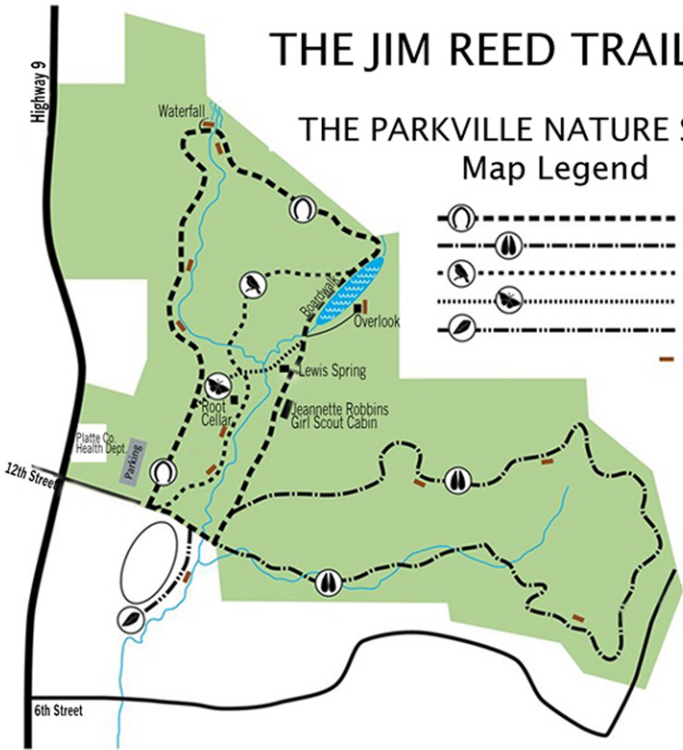
Dogs, horses and other pets are not permitted on the trails because they disturb wildlife.
